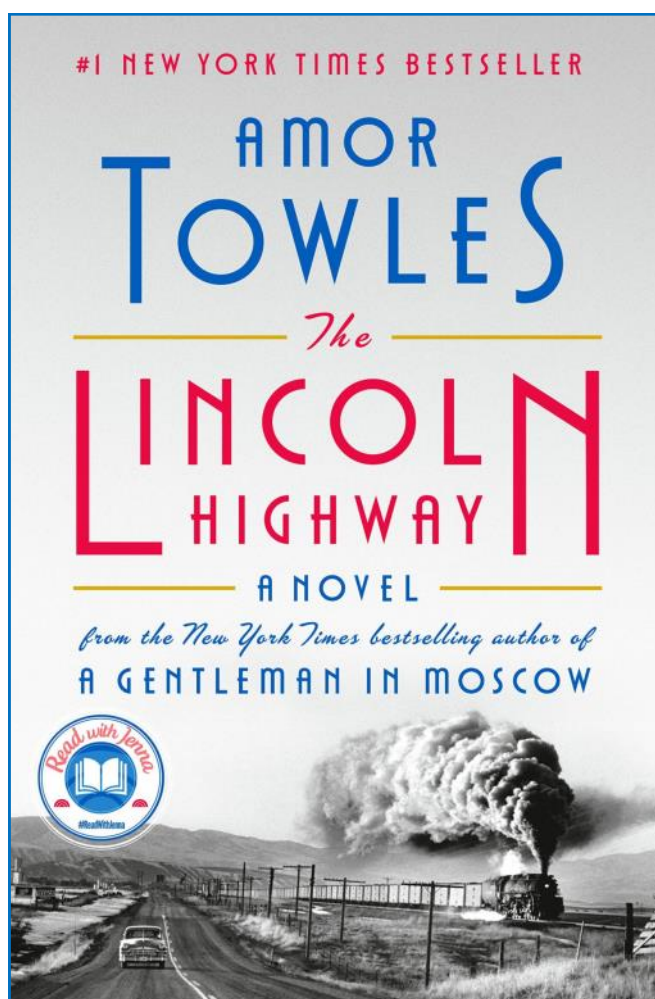

SUPERINTENDENT NEWS

April is here and hopefully warmer weather is as well. Greens are recovering from cold nights and the Tees and Fairways are starting to green up and grow. We have been spraying multiple apps of fertilizer on these areas. On April 20th, we will have a large spreader truck here with turf tires to fertilize all areas of the course, except for Greens. This will really get our Bermuda off to great start of the season.

Once the Greens start to really grow, we will begin vertical mowing to promote lateral growth, as well as help with thatch layers. If you have played recently, you may have noticed small holes punched in the greens. This helps with water movement/management as well as thatch control. In the growing season, we will continue to do this periodically as needed, but the holes will cover over in 2-3 days and will not affect ball roll. This process is needed to provide the best putting surface possible.

The New BIG PUTTING GREEN IS OPEN!!

Hats are expected to arrive late April and May If the shipping remains as stated, we should be well stocked in the golf shop for all your needs. We can make special orders as needed. All outerwear is 40% off in the golf shop.

Mercer University Women's Collegiate will be held April 3-5. Fourteen Colleges across the country make up the field. Let's go Mercer!!!

The April lady's clinics will be on Tuesday April 12th and Saturday April 23rd. The Tuesday April 12th clinic will begin at 11am and the Saturday April 23rd clinic will begin at 10:30am and both will last one hour. Cost is \$20 per session.

One of our biggest challenges we face is our Practice Facility. To provide a better experience for our members and their guests we will be posting hours of operation on a professional sign adjacent to the Practice Facility. This will allow plenty of time for practice, a safe environment for hand picking and more time for our staff to pick up balls that are needed for the next day. Your cooperation is greatly appreciated. This will begin when the professional sign is completed; most likely in the month of April. We have received a shipment of balls which are being put into the daily surplus. We still have 2 more orders that are scheduled to ship to us this month. Keep our fingers crossed.

The Brickyard PGA Junior Golf League has begun, and practices will be on Thursdays from 4pm-6pm. The Season starts April 1 through July 31. We will reach out to nearby clubs that are having a PGA Junior League and schedule home and home matches during the season. Match schedule will be in the coming months.

Please remember to call or cancel online your tee times if you're not using. Tee Times can be made 10 days out by either calling the golf shop or by reserving a tee time at our website. We've noticed an improvement during February on members signing in at the golf shop. Thank you. Please continue to signing in at the golf shop before going onto the course. Make sure that when reserving your tee time, either through calling the golf shop or online, you book it for one, two, three, four or five players. This ensures that other members don't book on your tee time when you're expecting more players than what is booked.

Effective, April 1st the right side of #1, #2 and half of #3 will be out of bounds. This is the proper course marking for these holes.

Lastly, check out the Brickyard website for information and utilize the member login tab. It allows you to make online tee times, view the tee sheets 10 days out and much more.

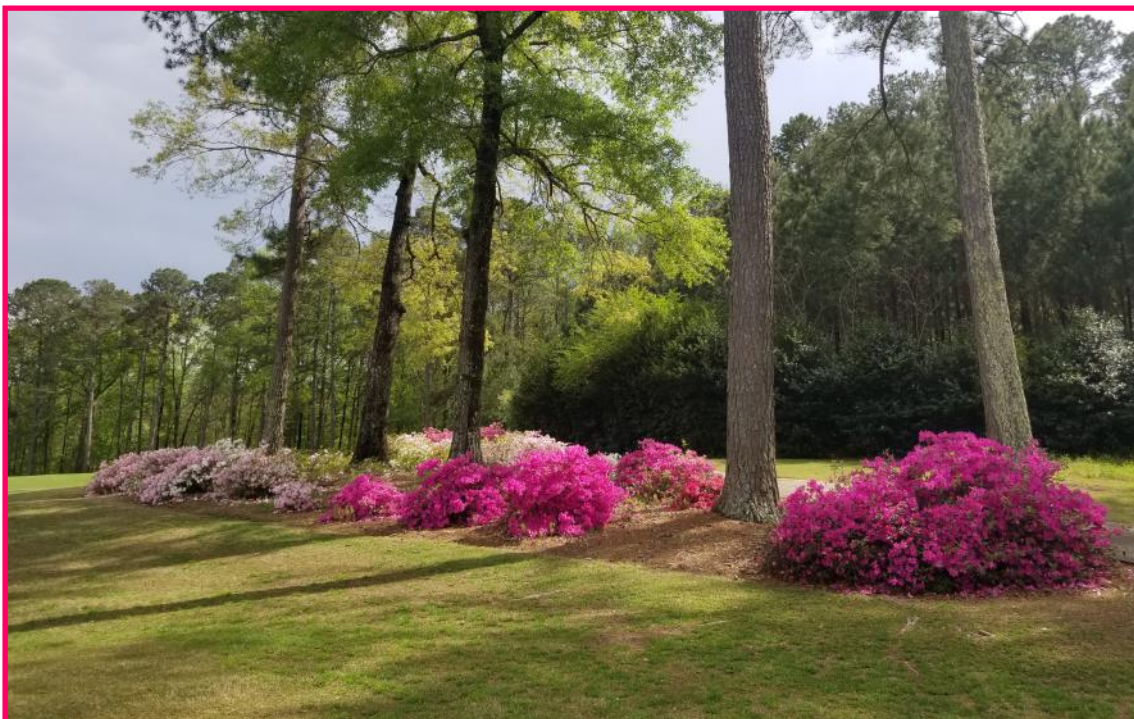

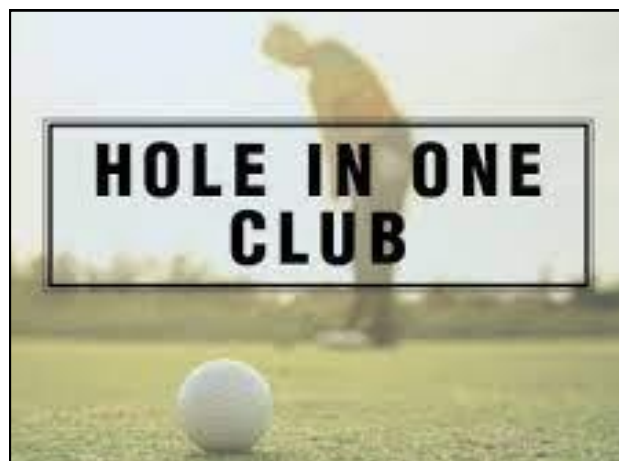
