GOLF COURSE NEWS

Good News

In response to our member's request, the golf course will remain open until 9pm. Please cooperate and be off the golf course promptly at 9pm. The Pro Shop staff will greatly appreciate it. The range will continue to close at 7:30pm Tuesday-Saturday and at 5pm on Sundays. This allows for proper preparation for setting up the range the following day and it also allows for regular mowing.

In July, our maintenance staff is in full swing in maintaining every aspect of the golf course. We will continue to mow fairways twice a week, but we have changed the mowing pattern this year. The Fairways are now shaded a light green down the right side and a darker shade on the left. This pattern is one of my personal favorites mainly because it highlights the center of the fairway with the color change. The green shades indicate which direction this grass was mowed. For example, the lighter shade of green indicates the grass was mowed in that direction and the darker was mowed the opposite. It is very important to change these mowing patterns year to year to prevent the grass from forming growth habits. It is so important that our greens program schedule changes every day. Our greens mowing schedule is based on an analog clock Saturday greens are mowed in the direction 3 to 9, Sunday they are mowed 6 to 12, Monday 11 to 5 and so on.

Some other areas of the course we are working on are the native areas. They will be bush hogged first and then sprayed for weeds. These areas will be moved 3 to 4 times per year as they are native areas and not always in play. Also we have dedicated a mover to mow a few areas at a higher height of cut to help your golf ball from going in the hazard. These areas include around 4, 6, 11, 12, and 17 greens in the rough areas.

Also with the higher temps, you may see myself or a staff member hand watering some dryer areas on greens. Yes we have irrigation, but it is important to keep the moisture levels on greens as even as possible to provide the best playing conditions. Thank you all and remember please fill your divots and repair your ball marks.

Effective 8-1-22, please sign the bottom of your cart receipts. This states that you will take care of the carts and are responsible for any damages and the missing bag cooler, should you use one. This new process with a few enhancements will condition the members, so that when the new carts arrive, it won't be a surprise.

Please remember to call or cancel online your tee times if you're not using. Tee Times can be made 10 days out by either calling the golf shop or by reserving a tee time at our website. We've noticed an improvement during the past few months on members signing in at the golf shop. Thank you. Please continue signing in at the golf shop before going onto the course. Make sure that when reserving your tee time, either through calling the golf shop or online, you book it for one, two, three, four or five players. This ensures that other members don't book on your tee time, when you're expecting more players than what is booked. Lastly, check out the Brickyard website for information and utilize the member login tab. It allows you to make online tee times, view the tee sheets 10 days out and much more. If you need help setting yours up, see the front office ladies and they will get you set up.

<u>Brickyard Youth Outing</u>

Hey members, we wanted to share with you that two of our members, Trey Dickerson and Doug Senn are organizing a weekly outing for our youth golfers. The objective is to get some practical on course experience with the other youth and everyone is invited to join them. Golfers ages 13 and up will be playing their own ball, stroke play from the Blue Tees. Golfers age 8 to 12 will be paired up and will play a scramble format from the Red Tees. All golfers are expected to walk 9 holes and carry their own bag or use a pull cart. When there is a heat advisory, bags can ride, but golfers must walk; there is no cost for members, who are walking. There is also no cost for non-members walking, who are in the PGA Jr League. Non-members walking, who are not in PGA Jr League, costs \$20 for 9 or 18 holes.

There should be at least one adult riding in a cart with each group, with cold drinks and towels and to assist if necessary. Therefore when there are more than 5 golfers, another adult will be needed to help Doug. They plan to play every Tuesday morning after 10:00, as Tee Times permit, with Wednesday being a back-up day in case of bad weather or other conflicts. All golfers should sign-in at the Pro Shop with a club number. There is no cost or obligation to attend every week.

No coaching, teaching, or assistance is intended or implied. With experience being such a good teacher, this is meant to be for the youth to simply learn from their experience on the course, with their peer group. For Coaching or Lessons, please see a teaching professional. We recommend Derek and Blair for that and or join the clubs PGA Jr. League, on Thursday from 4pm to 6pm.
