GOLF COURSE NEWS

During the month of June, we will begin our more aggressive greens programs. We have already been doing these practices, but now we can do them more frequently. This will include vertical mowing or (verti cutting). This process uses a different set of reels on our mower to cut into the ground vertically removing small amounts of thatch and cutting Bermuda runners. Some of the benefits of verti cutting are it removes

excess leaf growth making greens smoother. It creates channels for topdressing sand to fall into. Also, it promotes upright growth of the leaf blades helping with grain issues and sponge like feeling greens. These are just a few benefits of verti cutting.

Other practices on our greens program will include spraying greens with lower rates of fertilizers more often. Lowering the rates and going more frequently allows us the use of more PGRs and have a better control on ball speeds and plant health. Light top dressing will be periodically applied to greens to help with thatch and ball roll as well. These top dressings will not be heavy applications and will only improve playability. We have started double cutting, grooming, and rolling with brushes as well.

In May we aerified greens aggressively and they have recovered nicely. This process has showed dramatic improvement in our greens overall health. If you have been out to the course, you have seen the Par 3's Tee top replacement. We removed the old grass and some soil then leveled the tee tops out on these Tees adding a greens mix type soil. After that, we put down certified TifTuf Bermuda grass. This grass is a shade tolerant Bermuda with aggressive growing habits to recover quickly for divots. These Tee's will be open any day now. Brand New EZ-GO Elite Lithium Battery golf carts with Pace 7EX GPS will arrive between September 11-October 9th this year. To keep our carts free from damage, we have a new process in place. Please sign the bottom of your cart receipts. This states that you will take care of the carts and are responsible for any damages and the missing bag cooler should you use one. This new process with a few enhancements will condition the members so that when the new carts arrive, it won't be a surprise.

Please remember to call or cancel online your tee times if you're not using. Tee Times can be made 10 days out by either calling the Golf Shop or by reserving a tee time at our website. We've noticed an improvement during the past few months on members signing in at the Golf Shop. Thank you. Please continue signing in at the Golf Shop before going on to the course. Make sure that when reserving your tee time, either through calling the golf shop or online, you book it for one, two, three, four or five players. This ensures that other members don't book on your tee time when you're expecting more players than what is booked. Lastly, check out the Brickyard website for information and utilize the member login tab. It allows you to make online tee times, view the tee sheets 10 days out and much more. If you need help setting yours up, see the front office ladies and they will get you set up.

Message from the President



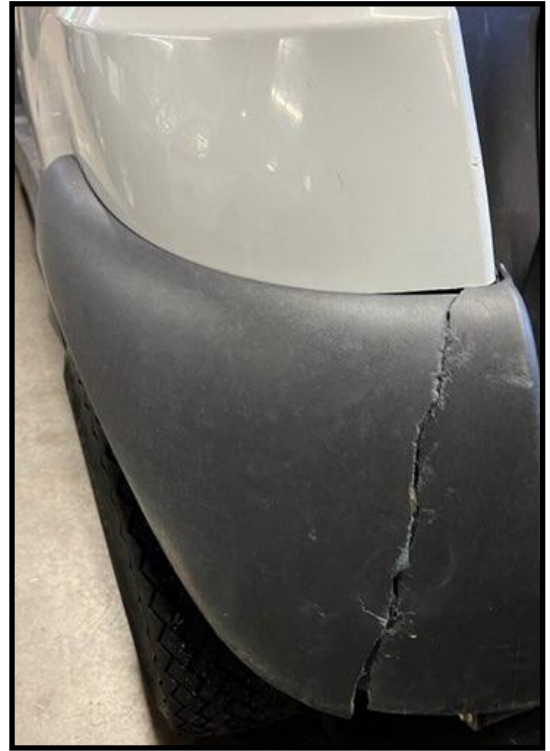
Please take a look at

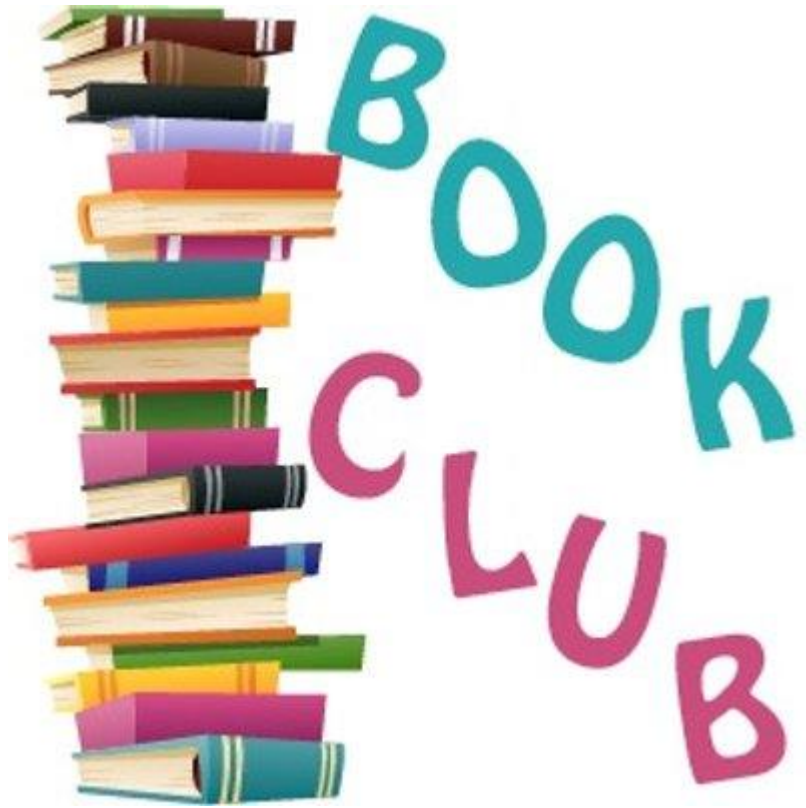




Join the Brickyard Ladies on June 21st at 5:30pm
