We have been working hard to keep a fresh cut and cleaning up all the clippings after the cutting. The blowers have been working extra hard!

The greens are in great shape heading into the cooler months. Our surface management program has been very successful this year. The long term health of the greens is right on track!

We have started all our pre-emerge applications. Timing is essential in trying to rid the course of the winter weeds. We hope to be even cleaner than we were last year.

We will be tackling a few small projects this month. We plan on getting the cart paths edged, some small trees cut down, and some cleaning of the grasses around the ponds. We will also continue to BushHog the chordgrass to keep it manageable. Thanks to Theron Ussery for his work on #17 pond, job well done!

Please remember to fix your divots and ball marks, and rake up your footprints in the bunkers. Keep in mind that others will be playing behind you!!

A Message from the President



On July 15th we received our new Club Car carts ; I was very happy to provide these new carts for our member's enjoyment. In less than a month of use there has been quite of bit of damage done to many carts. Some of the damages are as follows:

- broken windshield
- hole punched through bumper
- cooler bracket broken off
- front fender kicked in
- front end damage caused by jumping curbs
- split rear bumper
- side piece broken off
- sand bottle racks broken
- support bracket for top broken

There are other damages not mentioned that also need to be repaired. The cost of repairs will be several thousand dollars, which I should not be facing since the carts are only a month old. If this is the pattern going forward, I will have no choice but to raise cart fees. That means that the majority of the members who do not cause damage will be paying for the minority of the members who do not care or can not control their temper. I do understand that there are accidents which occur with no malicious intent.

I have explored options for keeping up with who rents carts but have determined that there is no economical method available. Therefore it is incumbent on all players to monitor and report abuses or accidents to the Pro Shop. In my opinion, anyone who witnesses damage to a cart should encourage the person causing the damage to report it and if he does not, then that person should do so. Like I said earlier, if this continues, everyone will eventually pay by increasing the cart fee. Golf is a game of honesty and integrity and this applies to the use of our carts. Please report any damages you witness to the Pro Shop, so I can hold those responsible accountable.

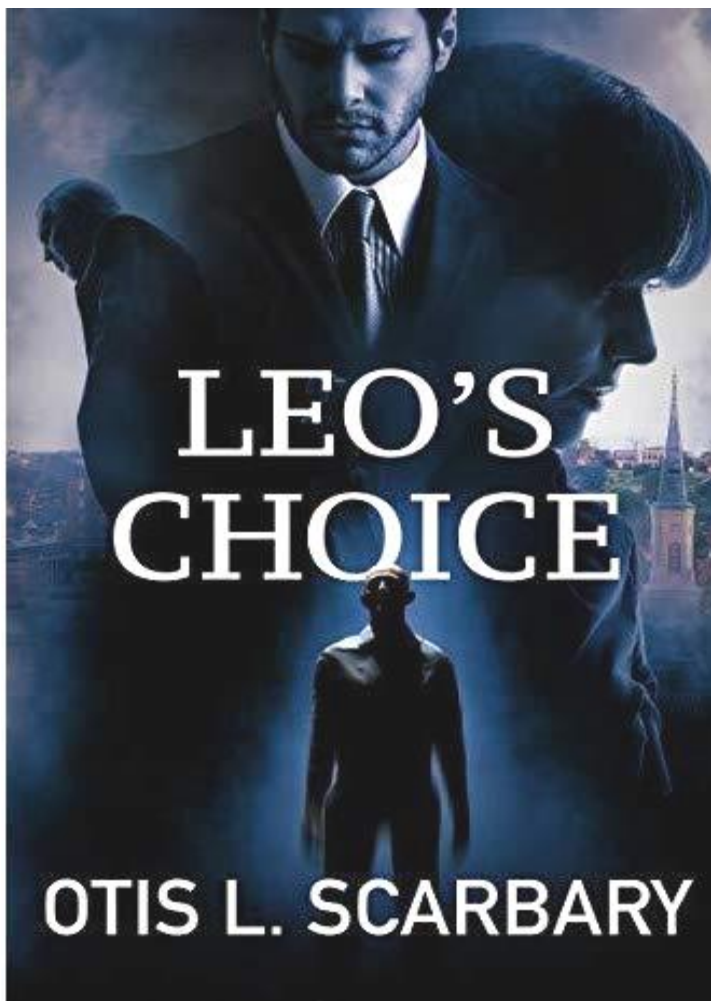
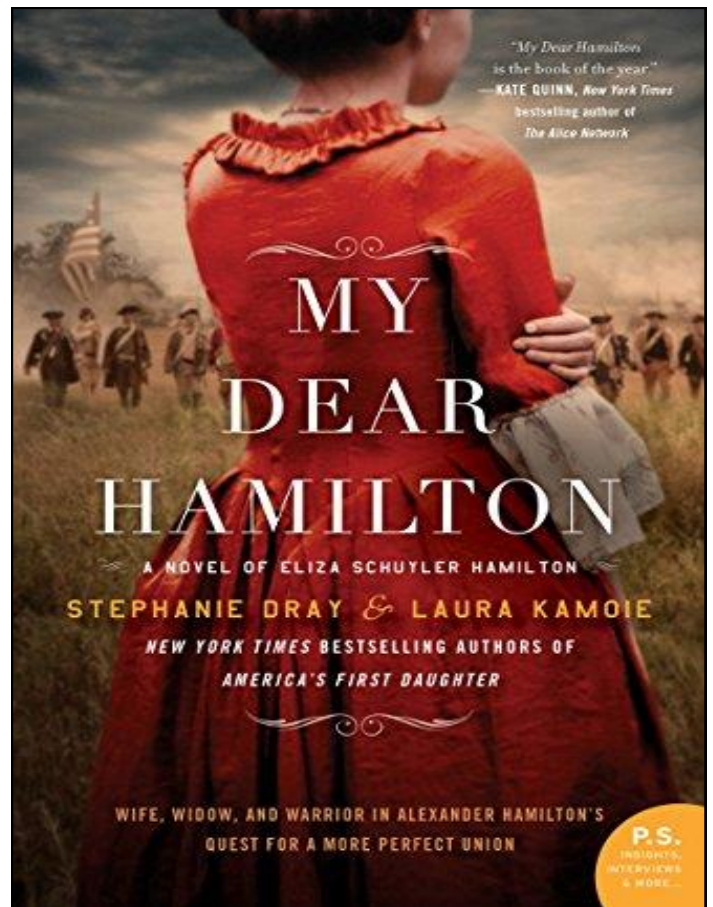
