# GOLF COURSE NEWS

September on the golf course is very busy for our golf course maintenance staff. We are preparing the course for the soon to be weather change, while also maintaining the best conditions we can for everyday play. A few things we are currently working on are: Preemergent applications, Overseeding Par 3 Tee's, and changing the Height of Cut (HOC) in certain areas of the course, so when temperatures drop, we are ready.

Our preemergent applications will begin on the rough. First, we will spray all the roughs with a preemergent, PGR, and fertilizer. After roughs are complete, we will move to fairways and tees with the same preemergent, but with different fertility. Last will be approaches around greens. This will be a split application of a different preemergent as not all chemicals are labeled for or near greens. The split application gives you better coverage in these areas. There is a soil temperature range for the perfect timing of these applications that we are trying to hit. (75-65 degrees is ideal)

On the Par 3's, we will be fertilizing tees ahead of time to allow the seed to grow in quickly. Also before we seed, we will be scalping and verticutting the grass to prepare for a better seed bed. Next, we will seed with a 3-way perennial Ryegrass seed. Then we will topdress the tee tops, fertilize again with a good starter fertilizer and water, water, and water.

On our fairways and tees, we will start slowly raising the HOC. Currently we are mowing at .500 or ½ an inch. First, we will raise to .600 while we are still slowly growing, then we will finish at .700-.750. We do this because of cart traffic and foot traffic. With Bermuda grass, when cooler temperatures arrive the grass blade tightens up and starts to lay down. By raising our HOC slightly we can simulate our current playing conditions year round.

The Junior Tour powered by Under Armour is schedule to have an event on Sunday December 11<sup>th</sup> at 1pm. Boys and Girls ages 6-18 will play 9 holes for all four age divisions. With the golf season being year-round here in Georgia, tournament golf and players being shuttled to holes, in between holes and to the club house at the end of the round at times can be dangerous. We lost a GSGA adult to a fatal accident where the adult fell off the back of the golf cart. With that being said, all bottoms need to be seated.

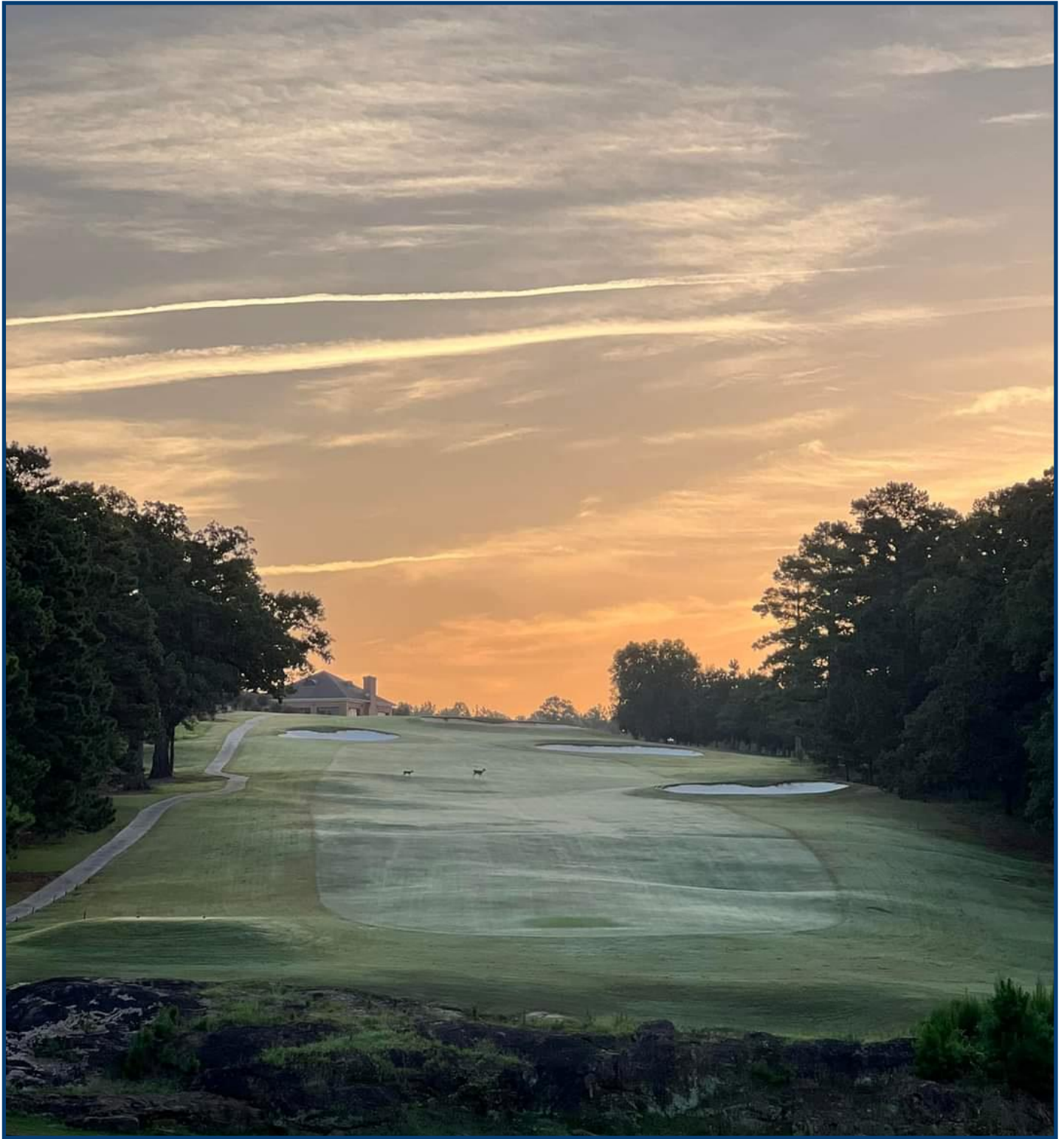

# *A Message from the* **PRESIDENT**

Between September 1 and October 10, 2022 a new fleet of carts will arrive. These are E-Z-Go RXV Elite carts featuring lithium batteries, 10 inch GPS monitor with Pace Technology, and automatic brakes. Lithium batteries are warranted for seven years and will charge in 3 hours instead of 12 hours for lead acid batteries. No more carts running out of juice and no more corroded battery cables breaking.

Due to inflation and the high cost of lithium batteries, the monthly payment will more than double what we are paying now for the Club Car carts. For this reason it is necessary to increase the cart rental from \$19 to \$23 effective October 1, 2022. This increase was calculated to be a breakeven between the current payment and the new payment based on average annual rounds. For those on the Unlimited Cart Plan, you will have two options: agree to pay \$145 per month under a new agreement OR opt out of the plan altogether. The current agreement states that management has the right to change the current fee at the anniversary date or to discontinue the plan. If everyone in the plan selects one of the options above, the plan will continue under new terms. If not, the plan will be discontinued. Those who wish to continue in the plan will need to sign a new agreement and those that want to opt out will need to notify the club in writing by September 26, 2022.

I want everyone to understand that the increase in rental rates is not going to increase the club's margin on cart rentals and will only cover the increase in the cost of the carts. The increase in the unlimited plan is based on keeping the ratio the same as \$19 is to \$120.

I hope everyone enjoys the new carts.

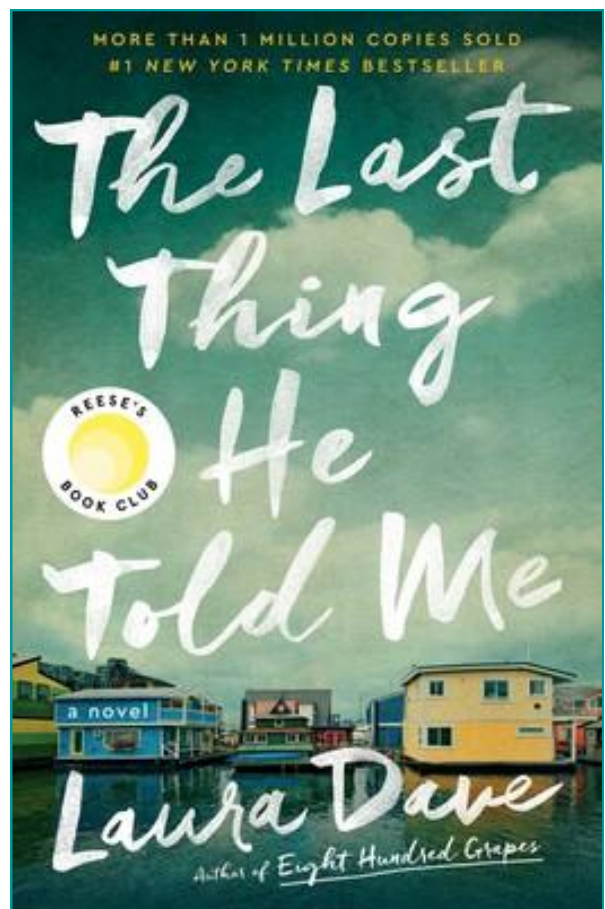
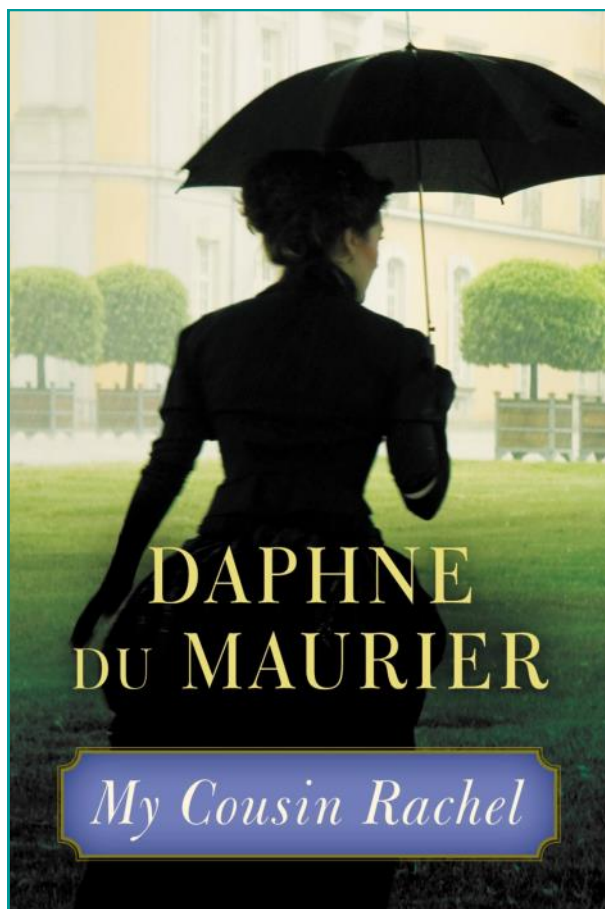
