I hope everyone is enjoying the last of the summer months. The temperatures should start to fall which means the grass will start to slow it's growing down. We have been working hard to keep a fresh cut and cleaning up all of the clippings after the cutting. The blowers have been working extra hard!!!

Please remember to stay behind the white lines. Please follow these lines back to the cart paths when getting near the green complexes. We are trying to eliminate all of the traffic around the greens. We have also placed a few signs out to remind everyone of this.

The greens are in great shape heading into the cooler months. Our surface management program has been very successful this year. The long term health of the greens is right on track!! We have a plan to eliminate the *poa annua* getting into them this year. We have started all of our pre-emerge applications one month earlier than normal to try and get a jump on the germination of the weeds.

Please remember to fix your divots and ball marks, and rake up your footprints in the bunkers. Keep in mind that others will be playing behind you!!

#### From the Head Pro

I want to thank everyone for being so kind to me as I am getting acquainted with the Macon area and the Brickyard as well. I am still working on putting names and faces together, so please be patient with me for a little while longer.

We have several big member events coming up (Fall Member-Member, September 16th & 17th as well as Member Guest, October 6th-8th). These are events that are handicapped and handicaps are what I want to discuss here for a minute.

I have had several members mention the need for a handicap committee to ensure that we have an even playing field for all member-related events. The best way to ensure that these events are fair is to use the USGA handicapping system and to do what I call "peer reviews" of members handicaps. I am in the process of establishing a committee that will be checking the frequency of members posting scores versus their rounds played. We will develop a plan to ensure members are posting their scores after playing to create a level and even playing field for member events. There will be consequences for those caught playing and not posting scores.

Also to ensure level playing fields in the future, we will start posting members scores from tournaments here at The Brickyard as Tournament scores in their handicap. Tournament golf is the most accurate way to judge an individual's handicap and ability on the golf course.




