





October 3, 2023.....Senior <u>Tobias Jonsson</u> put the finishing touches on the sixth tournament title of his collegiate career on Tuesday when the Swede carded a 3-underpar 69 to stay stop the 100-man field at the Mark Simpson Colorado Invitational at the par-72, 7,787-yard Colorado National Golf Club.

Jonsson (-9) was solid throughout the event in northern Colorado, tallying below-par scores in all three rounds in holding off Colorado's Justin Biwer by a pair of strokes. He registered a quartet of birdies and just one bogey in Tuesday's final round.

GOLF COURSE NEWS



With November arriving, so are the colder temperatures and frost delays. Frost delays are put in place on the golf course to protect the grass from damage. Frost damage comes from when the leaf blade freezes not only on the outside, but the interior cell walls as well. The plant cells become brittle and walking or driving across the grass breaks and damages it. The damage may not be visible at first, but it is there and will become very visible in the future. Also, just because you don't have frost at your house or can't see it from the clubhouse doesn't mean we don't have any frost. Lower cut grass is the most susceptible. One of the main reasons for this is these areas receive the most concentrated traffic. Things like shade also influence the length of a delay, the more shade the more frost and we have plenty of trees producing shade at the Brickyard. Lastly regarding frost delays, the staff does not like frost delays any more than the members do. Please be patient and we will get you out on the course as soon as possible.

On the project side of things, the stream bank has been completed and turned out nicely. As for the bunkers, the new drains have been installed, shaping is complete, and sod has been laid. We are currently waiting for the capillary concrete to be poured. Once the capillary concrete has been poured the sand will be installed. The sand is already onsite we are just waiting on the capillary. The practice bunker, number 9, and number 14 will be completed this year with the others to be done starting in the spring/ early summer.

Going out of the growing season, I feel that the maintenance staff has done all that we can to go into winter dormancy and come out of the spring ready to grow. We have applied all fungicides, pre-emergent, pigment, and fertilizer to have a successful summer next year and the timing of all these is very important for the coming year. This winter if you are playing please be aware of the cart traffic and try to take different paths as you play.



Test your knowledge of the Rules of Golf The answers are on page 19.

- ♠ Rule 6.2.b (5) Player A is unable to find her ball after a 3 minute search. She returns to the teeing area to hit another tee shot under stroke & distance penalty. She drops a ball in the teeing area, the ball comes to rest in a very bad lie within the teeing area. As she addressed the ball, Player B told her she could have teed the ball up. Player A then tees the ball up and plays the hole out.
 - A) No problem. Thank you Player B.
 - **B)** Player A's ball was in play when she dropped it; therefore, she is penalized 2 strokes for playing from a wrong place.
 - <u>C)</u> In addition to the penalty in answer B, Player B receives a 2 stroke penalty for giving Player A advice.
- ♦ Rule 11.26(2) Player A & B are playing a match. Player B's ball lies on the putting green 5 feet behind the hole. Player A's ball is 15 feet above the hole. B asks A if he would like for him to mark his ball. A declined as he felt B's ball was no problem. A putts and his ball rolls past the hole and hits B's ball.
 - <u>A)</u> Player B must replace his ball, and A plays his where it came to rest, and is penalized 2 strokes.
 - **B)** Both balls are played as they lie, no penalty.
 - C) Player A loses the hole.
 - D) There is no penalty, A plays the ball as it lies, B must replace his ball.
- Rule 20.1c (3)(4) A player's ball lies in a rut made by a vehicle. Not sure if the rut is ground under repair, the player decides to play 2 balls and wants the 2nd ball to count. He plays the original ball from the rut, and plays the 2nd ball dropped as free relief from the rut. The original ball is hit on the green 2 feet from the hole, so the player decides not to play the 2nd ball. After play, the committee rules that the rut was ground under repair.
 - A) Player is disqualified for failing to hole out with the 2nd ball.
 - B) Player is penalized 2 strokes for playing a wrong ball as he was granted relief.
 - <u>C)</u> Score with original ball counts.
