

No Limit Hold'em Tournament

We would like to invite all 21+ year old members to join us in our first <u>No Limit Hold'em Poker</u> <u>Tournament.</u> This fun filled event will be limited to the first 24 players to register due to a limited number of seats and chips at this time. A \$30.00 per player registration fee will go to the 100% payout prize pool. The payout structure will be: $1^{st} 40\%$, $2^{nd} 30\%$, $3^{rd} 20\%$, $4^{th} 10\%$ and 5^{th} wins the dreaded, bubble boy brick.

This event will be held on Thursday August 15, 2019. Registration begins at 5:00 pm in the pavilion with cash payment of the \$30 entry fee. The tournament will begin at 5:30 pm. Registration will close at 6:00 pm or once all 24 seats are taken. There will be no rebuys.

We will play 25-minute levels with blinds and antes starting at 25/50 and doubling every level after that. The starting stacks will be 3,000 chips per player and there will be a 15-minute break after each three levels, where chips will be colored up as necessary.

Since it is a 100% payout, we will not have designated dealers. This means each player will be dealing their own button. If requested, Table Captains are asked to provide instructional assistance only. Players may be randomly moved by the tournament floor person to keep the number of players per table balanced or to combine to fewer tables.

Food and Beverages will be available at regular club prices. Thanks to Mr. Hutchinson and everyone for their support of this event.

Golf Tip of the Month

The two pictures you see are the position of the club at the top of the backswing and the position of the club in the finished position of the forward swing. At the top of the backswing the right shoulder is in the triangle position formed by the player's forearms at the top of the backswing in picture #1. In picture #2 the player has his left shoulder in the triangle position formed by the player's forearms at the follow- through and finished position of the golf swing. What happens on the backswing must be a mirror opposite image on the forward swing. If you can get the golf club in this backswing and forward swing position the quality of shots you hit when you play and practice will improve immediately.

I hope everyone has enjoyed their summer at The Brickyard. We have been hard at work keeping the Golf Course in the best possible playing conditions. Our new skid steer came in and we have been busy clearing a lot of the overgrown areas around the course. As a safety note, if you ride up to an area where we are using this, please stay clear as debris is thrown very far distances. We edged all the bunkers on the course and sprayed them for any weeds that might be popping up. We verti-cut the tees and collars and fertilized them. Our normal weekly surface management was done on the greens. We have sprayed for those pesky summer time weeds. A lot of mowing and clean up.

We also had a company called Gold Mine Golf come in and help us with some irrigation issues. They went around to all our greens and raised the greens irrigation heads up and installed new nozzles. They also went around to certain holes and helped us replace some electric solenoids that were faulty. This has helped us be more efficient with our watering.

In August we prepare for the Dixie Classic. We want to showcase our course for some of Middle Georgia's best golfers!


Happy Hour Fridays!



Unexampled Courage

On February 12, 1946, Sergeant Isaac Woodard, a returning, decorated African American veteran, was removed from a Greyhound bus in Batesburg, South Carolina, after he challenged the bus driver's disrespectful treatment of him. Woodard, in uniform, was arrested by the local police chief, Lynwood Shull, and beaten and blinded while in custody. President Harry Truman was outraged by the incident. He established the first presidential commission on civil rights and his Justice Department filed criminal charges against Shull. In July 1948, following his commission's recommendation, Truman ordered an end to segregation in the U.S. armed forces. An all-white South Carolina jury acquitted Shull, but the presiding judge, J. Waties Waring, was conscience-stricken by the failure of the court system to do justice by the soldier. Waring described the trial as his "baptism of fire," and began issuing major civil rights decisions from his Charleston courtroom, including his 1951 dissent in Briggs v. El*liott* declaring public school segregation per se unconstitutional. Three years later, the Supreme Court adopted Waring's language and reasoning in Brown v. Board of Education. Richard Gergel's Unexampled Courage details the impact of the blinding of Sergeant Woodard on the racial awakening of President Truman and Judge Waring, and traces their influential roles in changing the course of America's civil rights history.
