

October is here and it's time for the cooler temperatures to come on in!!! Well, hopefully! As of this writing, we are still in the high 90's and have had 30 straight days with no rain. Once the cooler temps hit us, we will start raising the heights of cuts for the winter time. This will ensure that we have healthy grass throughout the winter months.

With the shorter days and cooler temperatures it means the leaves will start falling, so please be patient with us as we try to keep the course clean. We will have blowers going non stop every day.

We will also be over-seeding the Driving Range tee and all the par 3 tees again this year. We do this to try and keep a good stand of grass to hit the shorter tee shots into those greens.

We completed our fall application of pre-emerge to the entire course in September. We sprayed the whole course this year and went out a little earlier than normal to help try and keep those pesky winter weeds from breaking out this winter.

November Book Club Review


